



Task Manager, Power Button Reset or Hard Reset?

Task Manager ...

Use this option if your unit freezes. Press the **CTRL**, **ALT** and **DELETE** keys simultaneously. If this option fails, you will have to perform a Power Button Reset.

Power Button Reset

Press and hold the off/on button for 5 seconds. When the screen blacks out, release the button.

Use this method when:

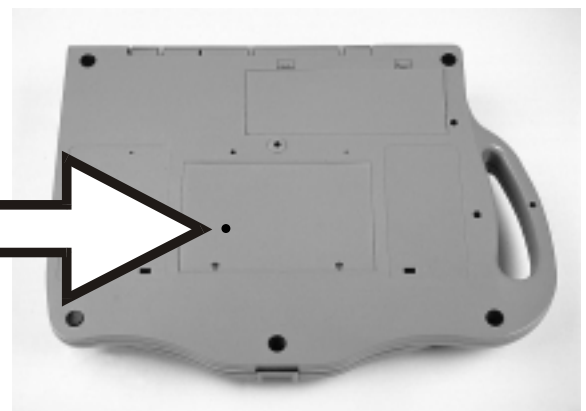
- software has quit operating and will not respond to commands or the touchpad
- you have made changes to IP settings
- you have made changes to Network Configuration settings

Hard Reset

Use a straightened paper clip to press through the hole in the center of the memory module compartment cover. This will press the reset button.

Use this method when:

- all other methods have been exhausted.



Warning!

This form of reset will delete any software that is not embedded (i.e. Any software stored on RAM will be deleted. This includes files and programs.) The unit will have only the software that was originally installed by the manufacturer.
